**PLAINTIFFS' MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT OF MOTION FOR TRANSFER  
OF ACTIONS TO THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF PENNSYLVANIA  
PURSUANT TO 28 U.S.C. § 1407 FOR COORDINATED OR  
CONSOLIDATED PRETRIAL PROCEEDINGS**

Plaintiffs Blair Berman, GERALYN Ritter, Jonathan Ritter, Felicidad Iban, Daniel Armyn, Nicole Armyn, Amy Miller, Maria Iban, Mariana Estrades, Tom Stadnik, Jen Stadnik, Samantha Pincus, Catherine Greenman, James Greenman, Martin Burke, and Ann Moyer (together, "Plaintiffs") respectfully filed this brief in support of their Motion an Order pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1407 transferring the cases listed in the attached Schedule of Actions to the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings before Judge Legrome Davis.

**I. Factual background**

All of the cases identified herein arise out of the derailment of Amtrak Regional Rail Train 188 on May 12, 2015 at approximately 9:23 p.m. The derailment occurred as the northbound train approached Frankford Junction in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, several miles northeast of 30<sup>th</sup> Street Station in Philadelphia. The train was traveling over 100 miles an hour when the derailment occurred, although the track in the vicinity of Frankford Junction curves sharply and is subject to a 50 m.p.h. speed limit. Of the 238 passengers and 5 crew members on board, 8 were killed as a result of the derailment. Over 200 people were injured, many critically.

At this time, 19 civil actions arising from the derailment have been filed by 42 plaintiffs in four federal district courts – the District of New Jersey, the Eastern District of New York, the Southern District of New York, and the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. (New cases are being filed regularly.) All of these actions involve the same nucleus of fact. All seek compensation for personal injuries suffered in the derailment. All are at a preliminary stage. The defendant National Railroad Passenger Corp. (known as “Amtrak”) has only filed a responsive pleading in one case, *Seidler et al. v. National Railroad Passenger Corp.* . As set forth below, 13 of the 19 actions were filed in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, where the derailment occurred. All 12 actions have been assigned to Judge Legrome Davis, one of the Eastern District’s most experienced active judges.

**II. Legal Argument**

Under 28 U.S.C. § 1407, all of these actions should be transferred to a single district court for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings before the same district judge.

Creation of an MDL will promote the just and efficient conduct of all such actions. As noted above, the actions arise from the same occurrence. They will involve the same factual and legal issues in advance of trial. They will involve the same discovery. In this context, an MDL proceeding will promote coordinated discovery, reduce the costs of litigation, and enable cases to proceed more efficiently to trial. An MDL also will conserve judicial resources by enabling one judge to manage common issues, thus avoiding the necessity for multiple district judges to address identical legal issues while preventing duplicative or conflicting pretrial rulings. *See In re Union Pacific R.R. Co. Empl. Practices Litig.*, 314 F. Supp.2d 1338, 1384 (J.P.M.L. 2004) (centralization helps to conserve judicial resources); *In re Charlotte Russe, Inc., Fair and Accurate Credit Transactions Act (FACTA) Litig.*, 505 F. Supp.2d 1377, 1378 (J.P.M.L. 2007) (creation of an MDL proceeding helps to prevent inconsistent trial rulings).

Additional considerations support the formation of an MDL to coordinate litigation related to the May 12 derailment. The Amtrak Reform and Accountability Act of 1997 imposes a liability of \$200 million on the aggregate allowable award to all rail passengers, against all defendants, including claims of punitive damages, arising from a single accident relating to rail passenger transportation. See 49 U.S.C. § 28103. The aggregate damages in litigation related to the derailment may exceed \$200 million, in which case coordinated supervision by one judge would be essential.

The Panel should transfer all of these actions to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania in particular. In selecting a particular transferee court under Section 1407, the Panel considers several factors, including “where the largest number of cases is pending, where discovery has occurred, where cases have progressed furthest, the site of the occurrence of common facts, where the cost and inconvenience will be minimized, and the experience, skill, and caseloads of

available judges.” MANUAL FOR COMPLEX LITIGATION (FOURTH) § 20.131 (2010). These factors strongly favor transfer of actions relating to the May 12 derailment to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, given the following considerations:

- The derailment occurred in the heart of Philadelphia, in the Port Richmond neighborhood, only a few miles from the federal courthouse. The critical events and actions leading up to the derailment also occurred in Philadelphia, in the stretch of track between 30<sup>th</sup> Street Station and the Frankford Junction.
- All of the deaths occurred in Philadelphia. All of the injuries occurred in Philadelphia. The vast amount of the emergency medical treatment was rendered in Philadelphia. Many of the medical witnesses and first responders are from Philadelphia, and millions of dollars in medical bills were incurred in Philadelphia.
- Therefore, discovery will concentrate substantially on events that occurred in Philadelphia.
- A clear majority of the federal cases arising from the derailment (11 of 16) have been filed in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. It is anticipated that many more cases will be filed in the Eastern District of Philadelphia.
- Motions for Entry of Protective Order have been filed in three of the cases pending in Eastern District of Pennsylvania. The issues raised in these motions regarding preservation and production of evidence, and Judge Davis’s decisions regarding same, will be applicable to every other case relating to the derailment. As a consequence, a MDL in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania will conserve judicial resources, and will prevent conflicting orders in other courts.

- The locomotive and train cars involved in the derailment, which are included in the Motions for Entry of Protective Order noted above, are being stored by Amtrak in Wilmington and Bear, Delaware, respectively, and therefore are significantly closer to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania than any other federal district court where actions are currently pending.
- Amtrak has a major office in Philadelphia, and Philadelphia is convenient for Amtrak witnesses who may need to travel from Amtrak's main office located in Washington D.C. Amtrak's Engineering offices in Philadelphia have responsibility for the maintenance of the tracks at issue and related infrastructure.
- Philadelphia is a convenient location for the parties and witnesses, who span the mid-Atlantic states and generally live along the Northeast Corridor along which Amtrak Regional Rail Train 188 was traveling. Philadelphia is also convenient for the counsel in the litigation.
- The Eastern District of Pennsylvania has extensive experience in handling MDL proceedings, and possesses the resources and expertise to host an MDL arising from the May 12 derailment, as reflected in the fact that the district currently hosts 17 MDL proceedings before 12 different district judges. *See MDL Statistics Report*, dated May 15, 2015 (attached as Exhibit "1"). In this regard, the Eastern District's Clerk's office is widely appreciated for its efficiency and capacity in handling MDL and all other judicial matters. The Eastern District also features 21 active judges (with only one vacancy) joined by an additional 20 senior judges; a total of 41 federal judges are working on the district's caseload, underscoring the

district's capacity to absorb an MDL proceeding related to a catastrophic incident that occurred in the heart of Philadelphia.

This Panel has previously consolidated and coordinated cases involving train derailments in the federal district in which those accidents occurred and in which the majority of actions have been filed. See *In re Train Derailment Near Amite, LA*, on Oct. 12, 2002, 269 F. Supp.2d 1378 (J.P.M.L. 2003); *In re Rail Collision Near Chase, Md.* on Jan. 4, 1987, 661 F. Supp. 69 (J.P.M.L. 1987); *In re Amtrak Train Derailment at Frankewing, Tenn.*, on Oct. 1, 1975, 431 F. Supp. 916 (J.P.M.L. 1977). This Panel's prior practice further militates in favor of establishing an MDL in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania.

As for the individual district judge to whom the cases should be assigned, the Panel should assign all cases arising from the derailment to Judge Legrome Davis. Judge Davis has been assigned all 11 cases relating to the derailment that have been filed in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. It is anticipated that many more cases will be filed in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania relating to the derailment, and that Judge Davis will be assigned all such future cases. In addition, Judge Davis is an experienced and well-respected district judge who has prior experience in handling MDL proceedings, including *In re: Comcast Corp. Peer-To-Peer (P2P) Transmission Contract Litigation*, MDL No. 1992, and *In re Plastics Additives Antitrust Litigation (NO. II)*, MDL No. 1684. Judge Davis' integrity and competence recently were discussed in the *Legal Intelligencer* on June 9, 2015 (attached as Exhibit "2"). He is both an appropriate and excellent choice for supervising this MDL process.

Given the numerous deaths and catastrophic personal injuries that resulted from the derailment, Plaintiffs anticipate that numerous additional lawsuits will be filed relating to the derailment of Amtrak Regional Rail Train 188, including wrongful death and survival actions on

behalf of the 8 persons who died, and personal injury claims by the passengers who suffered injury. Many of these suits will be filed in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania. The prospect of additional lawsuits further supports an Order transferring all related cases to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings under Judge Davis' supervision.

### III. Conclusion

For the foregoing reasons, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Panel issue an Order under 28 U.S.C. § 1407 ordering the transfer of all current and future actions related to the Amtrak derailment on May 12, 2015 to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, to be assigned to Judge Legrome Davis for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings.

## Judge Handling Amtrak Cases Known for Intellect, Empathy

U.S. District Judge Legrome D. Davis of the Eastern District of Pennsylvania—who has been tapped to preside over cases stemming from last month's Amtrak derailment in Philadelphia—is the right person for the job of handling the complexity of disaster litigation, according to those who know him.

Davis, who according to U.S. District Chief Judge Petrese B. Tucker of the Eastern District was randomly assigned to the incoming cases, has served for roughly 13 years on the federal bench. Prior to that, Davis was a judge in the criminal division of the Philadelphia Court of Common Pleas from 1987 to 2002. Before becoming a judge, Davis was a prosecutor in the Philadelphia District Attorney's Office.

Former Pennsylvania Supreme Court Chief Justice Ronald D. Castille, who was the city's district attorney when Davis was a prosecutor, said Davis' skill led him to put Davis in charge of the office's rape unit.

"He was an excellent prosecutor and he's parlayed that into the federal courts," Castille said. "He was a good trial lawyer in one of the most sensitive units we had and he'll probably bring that sensitivity to this tragedy."

Philadelphia Court of Common Pleas Judge Jeffrey Minehart, who supervises the court's criminal division, worked as an assistant district attorney alongside Davis. Minehart said Davis excels at handling administrative issues, stemming from Davis' own experience as supervising judge of the city court's criminal division.

Minehart said Davis is an innovator who made changes to Philadelphia's criminal justice system. For example, while in the District Attorney's Office, Davis set up designated plea rooms where prosecutors could negotiate with defendants.

Minehart added the breadth of cases that a federal judge handles has prepared Davis for what is to come in the Amtrak litigation.

"He's a judge that will dig in and get the job done," Minehart said.

James T. Giles, former chief judge of the Eastern District and current Pepper Hamilton lawyer, said Davis exhibits an even judicial temperament.

"He's an excellent judge. Extremely bright and he will give everyone a chance to have his or her say," Giles said. "He's capable of handling a case of any size and complexity."

The litigation could potentially have hundreds of plaintiffs, as the derailment left more than 200 people injured and eight dead.

"There's never an issue that's too complex for him," said Michael Engle, an attorney at Greenblatt, Pierce, Engle, Funt & Flores in Philadelphia who has tried cases in front of Davis.

"He's a very, very intelligent judge who cuts right through matters and gets to the heart of the case," Engle added.

Former Philadelphia Bar Association chancellor and Davis' friend, William P. Fedullo of Rosen, Schafer & DiMeo in Philadelphia, said Davis is respected even among those whom he has sentenced in criminal cases.

"I've seen him in civil and criminal court and treat defendants with such respect that they understand the sentence that they're getting," Fedullo said.

He added, "I know he's handled significant litigation and corporate litigation. He's actually sentenced corporate officers to prison, which is astonishing."

Fedullo, like others who spoke about Davis, emphasized Davis' intelligence and empathetic nature.

"People in the audience nod their heads because he's so wise. Here's a guy who was made to be a judge," Fedullo said.

The Legal previously reported that at least six cases have been filed against Amtrak in the Eastern District.

Multiple cases are being handled by the law firms of Kline & Specter and Saltz Mongeluzzi Barrett & Bendesky. At a news conference held in May, Saltz Mongeluzzi co-founder Robert Mongeluzzi repeatedly characterized the accident as "a scene out of hell," and within the derailed train cars, "a scene of indescribable horror."

The four plaintiffs in the suits handled by Kline and Mongeluzzi include Felicidad Redondo Iban, 64, of Leon, Spain, whose right arm was nearly severed in the accident; her cousin, Maria Jesus Redondo Iban, 55, who suffered a concussion and lacerations to the face; Daniel Armyn, 43, of Brooklyn, New York, who sustained three broken ribs and lost teeth; and Amy Miller, 39, of Princeton, New Jersey, who suffered back injuries and numerous cuts.

Reached Monday, Thomas R. Kline of Kline & Specter said in an email that the firms anticipate filing more cases, but have not yet done so.

The potential damages available for the victims of the derailment are capped at \$200 million as per a 1997 federal law.

The law, which has come under fire over the years for not adequately covering victims' damages from serious train accidents, mandates Amtrak have \$200 million in liability coverage for a single incident.
