**PLAINTIFFS' NOTICE OF APPEAL**

Notice is hereby given that Marvin Andrews, Elizabeth Andrews, Kathleen Davis, Pete Davis, Rosa Metzler, Volkmar Metzler, Judith Rodriguez, Linda Standerfer, Michael Weiser, and Randi Weiser, Plaintiffs in the above-styled cases, appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit from the judgments entered in these actions on January 3, 2017, in so far as those judgments reduced the amount of punitive damages awarded by the jury at trial.

All plaintiffs prevailed at trial and the jury awarded each of them compensatory and punitive damages. Plaintiffs moved for entry of judgment, requesting a judgment in the full amount of compensatory and punitive damages awarded by the jury. Defendants responded to Plaintiffs' motion for entry of judgment. The District Court entered judgments in favor of all plaintiffs, awarding the full amount of compensatory damages found by the jury to each

plaintiff, but reduced the amount punitive damages awarded by the jury to each plaintiff.

Plaintiffs hereby appeal the decision of the District Court to enter judgments in their cases awarding punitive damages for amounts less than what was found by the jury. The District Court should have entered judgment for the full amount of punitive damages found by the jury in these cases.




