ORDER

In accordance with the memorandum opinion entered this day;

It is **ORDERED** by the court that the defendant's motion for summary judgment (doc. 590) is hereby **GRANTED IN PART** and **DENIED IN PART**.

Said motion is granted to the extent that the court finds that the July 1, 2009, black box warning is adequate as a matter of law to warn of the risk of neuropsychiatric complications in patients taking Chantix. The remainder of said motion is denied, without prejudice to the defendant's right to file motions for summary judgment in individual cases regarding the running and/or expiration of the statute of limitations.
