ORDER

For the reasons stated in the Memorandum Ruling signed by this Court on the 27 day of October, 2014,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Defendants' Rule 59 Motion for New Trial [Rec. Doc. 4348] is GRANTED IN PART and DENIED IN PART, as follows:

- Defendants' motion for reduction of the punitive damages awards is GRANTED. The Takeda Defendants shall be ordered to pay \$27,656,250.00 in punitive damages, and Eli Lilly & Company shall be ordered to pay \$9,218,750.00 in punitive damages. The compensatory damages awards shall remain as given in the Compensatory Damages Stipulation [Rec. Doc. 4329].
- Defendants' motion for a new trial is DENIED.
