MINUTE entry before the Honorable Matthew F. Kennelly: Case management conference held on 5/11/2017. All unresolved items on the joint agenda are discussed. The first AbbVie-only bellwether trial will begin on 6/5/2017; the second will begin on 7/5/2017; the third will begin on 9/18/2017; and the fourth will begin on 1/8/2018. The first Auxulium-only bellwether trial will begin on 11/2/2017 or 11/5/2017 as discussed, the second will begin on 4/9/2018. The parties are directed to confer to attempt to agree upon a case management plan for mixed-use cases, and a joint status report in this regard is to be filed by 6/26/2017. Regarding the first AbbVie-only bellwether trial set for 6/5/2017, as discussed in open court, final exhibit lists are to be provided by 5/30/2017 and will-call witness lists by 5/31/2017. AbbVie is to file a 5-page proffer regarding its statute of limitations defenses in the Konrad case by 5/15/2017, and plaintiff is to file a response of equal length by 5/17/2017. A preliminary pretrial conference regarding the Konrad statute of limitations issue, to be conducted by conference call, is set for 5/18/2017 at 11:30 a.m. The final pretrial conference remains set for 5/25/2017 at 1:30 p.m. Case management conference is set for 6/28/2017 at 2:00 p.m. for Medical Mutual of Ohio v. AbbVie case only. Joint status report regarding Medical Mutual case is to be filed by 6/26/2017. Mailed notice. (pjpg,)
