MINUTE entry before the Honorable Matthew F. Kennelly: As the Court advised trial counsel after declaring a mistrial earlier today in the Konrad case (No. 15–cv–966), the overall time allocation for the trial to begin on July 5 is reduced by approximately one trial day, to a total of 78 hours, 39 per side. This is based on the Court's observation of four and one–half days of trial in the Konrad case and its understanding of the issues and the evidence in the case that is next up in the AbbVie bellwether schedule, the Mitchell case (No. 14–cv–9178). The Court also proposed permitting each side to use part of its allocation to make mini–summations at appropriate intervals (to be determined) during the trial and directs counsel to consider and confer about this.
