PAUL A. ENGELMAYER, District Judge:

Argument on the parties' *Daubert* motions is scheduled for April 10 and 11 and, if necessary, April 12, 2018. Argument each day will begin at 9 a.m. There will be an hour-long lunch break. The Court expects to adjourn each day at 5 p.m.

On March 23, 2018, the parties proposed a sequence as to the topics to be covered at argument. *See* Dkt. 151. The Court hereby approves that proposed sequence. The Court does not, however, adopt the rigid allocation of 30 minutes time for argument as to each expert, as individual experts may merit more or less time. For avoidance of doubt, the Court is persuaded that argument is merited on both sides' *Daubert* motions—those directed at plaintiffs' experts and those directed at Bayer's experts. While the Court is hopeful that argument will be completed by the end of the day on April 11, 2018, the parties are to continue to reserve April 12, 2018 in the event that additional time is needed.
