<u>CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 74</u> (Wave Order #1)

As of March 29, 2022, there are approximately 13,500 cases pending in this MDL proceeding, *In re: Proton Pump Inhibitor Products Liability Litigation*, and one group of bellwether cases has undergone discovery and a second bellwether group has been selected for case-specific discovery. The Court finds that case-specific discovery of additional cases is necessary to promote the just and efficient conduct of this litigation. Accordingly, the Court is hereby ordering the parties to work up cases simultaneously in waves. This order includes the first two hundred cases that will be worked up, and subsequent orders will be entered each quarter.

I. Selection of Wave One Cases

Wave One shall consist of the 200 cases identified on Exhibit A hereto.¹

¹ Cases in subsequent waves may be selected from other groups of cases.

These 200 cases were randomly selected from the group of cases that (a) were identified as Eligible Round 2 Cases pursuant to Paragraph I of Case Management Order ("CMO") No. 54 and (b) were not on the final list of 24 cases selected pursuant to Paragraph II.A.3 of CMO No. 54.

II. Case-Specific Fact Discovery for Wave One Cases

A. Between June 1, 2022 and December 31, 2022, case-specific fact discovery of the Wave One Cases shall take place.

- **B**. The following limitations shall apply to case-specific fact discovery:
 - Each Defendant² is limited to 10 interrogatories, 10 requests for production of documents and 10 requests for admission per case.
 - Plaintiffs are limited to 10 interrogatories, 10 requests for production of documents (including requests to produce sales representative custodial files) and 10 requests for admission to each Defendant.
 - In each individual case, each side will be entitled to take five(5) fact witness discovery depositions, which is inclusive of

 $^{^2}$ For the purposes of these discovery limitations, each defendant and its related entities will be treated as one defendant. For example, Takeda Pharmaceuticals U.S.A., Inc. (TPUSA) and Takeda Pharmaceuticals America (TPA), Inc. are related entities and treated as one defendant for purposes of these discovery limitations. Similarly, if more than one plaintiff is named (*e.g.* an individual and their spouse), plaintiffs are treated as one entity for purposes of these discovery limitations.

plaintiff, treating and prescribing physicians, and sales representatives.³

4. The deposition of any fact witness is limited to 3 hours absent agreement of the parties.

C. Special Master Reisman will consider modifications to the above limitations only upon good cause shown and only if resolution cannot be reached after the parties meet and confer.

D. The following deadlines shall apply for fact discovery for the Wave One Cases:

Deadline to serve written discovery requestsJuly 15, 2022Deadline to respond to written discoveryAugust 12, 2022Deposition deadline and close of fact discoveryDecember 31, 2022

III. Expert Discovery for Wave One Cases

A. Between January 1, 2023 and June 30, 2023, expert discovery for the

Wave One Cases shall take place.

B. Each expert witness disclosure shall include at least two dates when

each expert is available for a deposition. Depositions can only commence after

both sides' expert reports have been served.

³ To the extent disputes arise regarding the division of time between the parties for the deposition of treating physicians (three hours total absent agreement), such disputes should be referred to Special Master Reisman for decision.

C. Depositions of Plaintiffs' experts will be completed before depositions of Defendants' experts in the same discipline, absent agreement of the parties or permission from the Special Master.

D. The parties shall be required to coordinate the depositions of experts when they are utilized across multiple Wave One Cases.

E. The following limitations shall apply to expert discovery:

- Plaintiffs and each defendant are limited to no more than five experts per case (exclusive of treating physicians).
- The deposition of any expert witness is limited to 7 hours absent agreement of the parties.

F. Special Master Reisman will consider modifications to the above

limitations only upon good cause shown and only if resolution cannot be reached

after the parties meet and confer.

G. The following deadlines shall apply for expert discovery for the Wave One Cases:

Plaintiffs' Expert DisclosuresFebruary 1, 2023Defendants' Expert DisclosuresMarch 3, 2023Plaintiffs' expert witness rebuttal reportsMarch 31, 2023Deposition deadline and close of expert discoveryJune 30, 2023

IV. Depositions for Wave One Cases

A. The depositions of all Wave One Cases shall be taken in accordance with the terms set forth in CMO Nos. 40 and 45, subject to the following change:

- Plaintiffs shall have priority in questioning prescribers, treaters, and other health care professionals in the Wave One Cases designated by an odd number on Exhibit A.
- Defendants shall have priority in questioning prescribers, treaters, and other health care professionals in the Wave One Cases designated by an even number on Exhibit A.
- B. Special Master Reisman will consider modifications in individual

cases only upon good cause shown and only if resolution cannot be reached after the parties meet and confer.

V. Motions for Wave One Cases

A. The following deadlines shall apply for summary judgment and *Daubert* briefing:

Filing of *Daubert* motions Filing dispositive motions Responses to *Daubert* motions Responses to dispositive motions Replies to *Daubert* motions Replies to dispositive motions August 31, 2023 September 14, 2023 September 28, 2023 October 12, 2023 October 26, 2023 November 9, 2023 B. If the Court determines that a hearing or oral argument on summary judgment and/or *Daubert* motions, or limited/certain parts thereof, is necessary, such a hearing may be scheduled by the Court for a date to be determined by the Court.

C. If discovery reveals facts that could a support a motion that would be dispositive of the *entirety* of a plaintiff's claims against *all* named defendants, either side may seek permission from Special Master Ellen Reisman in the individual case to file an early dispositive motion on that issue. If such leave is granted in an individual case, Special Master Reisman shall set a briefing schedule at that time.

VI. Cases Ready for Transfer or Remand

A. Venue recommendations. By no later than November 17, 2023, the parties to each Wave One Case shall meet and confer concerning the appropriate venue for each cases, and the parties shall submit joint venue recommendations to Special Master Reisman by November 30, 2023. The parties' joint recommendations shall identify the cases about which the recommended venue is in dispute. Special Master Reisman may then request briefing concerning those Wave One Cases about which the parties disagree. Each party reserves the right to object to the venue selected by another party or the Court.

B. Upon completion of discovery and motions practice, the Wave One Cases where venue in the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey is not determined to be proper by the Court shall be transferred to a federal

district court of proper venue pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1404(a) (if directly-filed in this MDL), or remanded to the federal district court from which such case was initially transferred pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1407. The trial date for such cases transferred or remanded to other federal district courts shall be set by the judge to whom the transferred or remanded case is assigned.

C. Upon completion of discovery and motions practice, for any Wave One Case where venue in the United States District Court for the District of New Jersey is determined to be proper by the Court, the court will set a trial date in a separate order.
