CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 13 (Revised Scheduling Order – General Corporate and Expert Discovery; Dispositive Motions; Trial)

The Court revises Case Management Order No. 4 and Case Management Order No. 11, extending certain case deadlines, as follows:

I. GENERAL CORPORATE DISCOVERY DEADLINE

The deadline for completion of general corporate discovery is extended to December 9, 2024.

II. EXPERT DISCOVERY FOR BELLWETHER DISCOVERY POOL PLAINTIFFS

Plaintiffs shall now serve expert disclosures and reports by December 23, 2024.

Defendants shall now serve expert disclosures and reports by February 3, 2025.

Plaintiffs may now serve rebuttal expert reports by March 3, 2025.

Expert discovery now closes May 28, 2025.

III. MEDIATION

The deadline for the parties to identify a mediator is extended to February 10, 2025. The deadline for the parties to complete mediation is extended to September 22, 2025.

IV. SELECTION OF TRIAL CASES

The parties now have until May 12, 2025 to identify one plaintiff from the Bellwether Discovery Pool to be the first of two cases tried ("Trial Cases").

V. DISPOSITIVE/DAUBERT MOTIONS

The deadline for the parties to file dispositive and/or Daubert motions in the Trial Cases is

extended to June 9, 2025.

Oppositions to any dispositive and/or *Daubert* motions in the Trial Cases are now due July

14, 2025.

Replies in further support of any dispositive and/or Daubert motions in the Trial Cases, if

any, must be filed no later than July 28, 2025.

VI. MANNER AND ORDER OF TRIAL CASES

The deadline for the parties to submit, jointly or separately, a proposal on the manner of

trial, the order of the Trial Cases, and the timing of trial is extended to September 26, 2025.

Responses, if any, must be filed no later than October 3, 2025.
