**MINUTES AND ORDER**

On March 10 and 11, 2025, the Court held informal working sessions with counsel on search terms for custodial productions of electronically stored information.

The following attended in person on behalf of Plaintiffs: Ashlie Case Sletvold, Erin Copeland, Trent Miracle, Alyson Steele Beridon, Tim Becker, and Layne Hilton.

The following attended in person on behalf of Defendants Indivior, Inc., Indivior Solutions, Inc., and Aquestive Therapeutics, Inc.: Randall Christian, Mary Pawelek, Patrick DeLaune, and Jason Lundry.

Counsel presented their disputes over various search terms and other issues associated with searches and productions of custodial files. After discussion of some general, global issues, the Court and counsel worked, line by line, through a spreadsheet containing 229 rows of disputes, proposals, counter-proposals, and proposed compromises. At the end of each day of discussions, the parties withdrew certain disputes and agreed to various compromises, and the Court ruled on all outstanding, unresolved issues. Further, the Court directed counsel to memorialize those outcomes between themselves and to advise the Court by close of business

Friday, March 14, 2025 whether there were any needed clarifications or remaining disagreements that required the Court's attention. If so, the Court will address those issues promptly, as soon as Saturday, March 15, 2025, to allow the collection and review of custodial files to begin.
